Sir,-

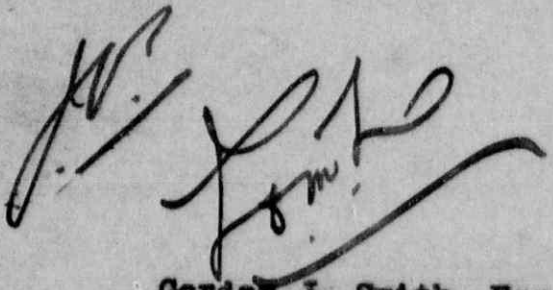
I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant with reference to the amount required by the Principal to finance the Mohawk Institute to the first of November, next.

In reply I beg to say that since the first instant cheques to the amount of \$4,630.00 have been sent, comprising the sum of \$2,630.00, the balance of grant due for the September quarter, and an advance of \$2,000.00 on the current quarter. Mr. Scott intends visiting Brantford in the near future and will discuss with you and Mrs. Boyce the financial arrangements to be made to carry on this school. In the meantime it is considered that the amount sent will enable the Principal to meet current expenditure.
