DOMINION. Two more new stores are being opened at Paroboro. May 18th will be Harbour Day in the N. B. schools.

Mr. Fred C. Rand, of Canning, N. S., has been appointed Collector of Customs in place of Ebenezer Rand, Esq., superannuated.

James Curtis, Esq., has been re-appointed High Sheriff for Queens County, P. E. I., and Messrs. Strong and McDonald for Prince and King's counties respectively.

Mr. Simpson Woodbury, of Turbork, N. S., has killed 413 fur-bearing animals during his lifetime as follows:—Foxes, 200; otters, 13; bears, 2; moose, 13; mink, 150; sable, 5; raccoons, 20; loup-cervier, 10; total, 413.

The Patriotic says that Messrs. D. Farquharson and Capt. R. McMillan, of Charlottetown, have purchased a steamer of 210 tons in England to be used in the coal and produce trades.

Mr. Charles Tupper gives notice to amend the customs act by omitting coal and coke from the list of articles which are prepared to make free when the United States makes them free.

A new pier is to be built near the T. P. Co., at Campbell's, this spring. Since Monday, the steamer of the I. S. B. Co., are making three trips a week from St. John to Eastport, Portland and Boston.

The directors of the Jacques Cartier Bank, Montreal, have declared a half year dividend of three and a half per cent, an increase of a half per cent over previous half year.

According to figures recently published no fewer than 23,804 persons were evicted from their homes in the city of New York from non-payment of rent during the period from September, 1885, to December, 1887.

John T. Ha-ke has been sentenced to two months in jail and fined \$200.00 for publishing certain articles in the Moncton Mercury, relating to the case of the Westmoreland controverted election.

The Dominion government is being awakened to the possibility of Asiatic cholera in Canada this summer. A deputation representing the Ontario and Quebec Boards of Health waited on the Cabinet ministers last week on this subject.

Before her departure from Florence, Queen Victoria gave \$200 to the poor. The late widow of Zanibar leaves twenty-seven widows and 250 children.

The London, G. B., Canada Gazette says the government has now given its word that the new service, by whomsoever supplied, shall be fully up to the standard of the requirements of the time, and arrangements with the imperial government as regards the Pacific mail service will speedily proceed and are expected to reach a speedy conclusion.

The loss to the lumber interest in Minnesota by the recent floods is put at \$250,000, and at Wisconsin to manufacturing industries at \$100,000.

A syndicate of English and Minnesota millers is being formed with a capital of \$1,000,000, to ship Dakota and Minnesota wheat direct to Liverpool.

In order to take advantage of the scheme it is only necessary for the person desiring it to pay instalments varying from 50 cents to \$1.50 per month, according to the class.
