

1909—Dave Smith, the Australian middleweight, began his puglilatic career by knocking out Res Dempsey in the 1st round. He defeated the beat men of his weight in Australia, and in 1910 won on a foul from Billy Papke in a bout at Sydney advertised as for the world's middleweight title. In 1911 he defeated Jimmy Clabby and Cyclone Johnny Thompson, but was knocked out by Billy Papke. After fighting a draw with Clabby in Sydney, he came to America, and in his first bout was defeated by Eddle McGoorty.

1910—Ad Wolgast defeated Freddle Cole in 8 rounds at Munich, Ind.
