1400 oak and pine Soil clay
1400 Still descending Sand and wood as before
400 a small stream from which a beautiful spring
issues forth, forming a rivulet.
400 bounding wood as before soil the same as last
600 Descending to Kings Lake. Soil as before
Wood the same more pine

right angle triangle and contains sixty tree acres and
