

Assem. from g.e. 1871 until Jan., 1874, when he resigned and was elected to the Commons for the same constituency at g. e. 1874. Sworn of the Privy Council as Minister of Inland Revenue, Sept., 1877, which office he held until the resignation of the Govt., 1878; defeated in Drummond and Arthabaska upon appealing to his constituents; elected immediately after for Quebec East, upon resignation of Hon. I. Thibaudeau. Re-elected g.e. 1878, 1882, 1887 and 1891. Was also an unsuccessful candidate for Richmond and Wolfe at last g.e.. A Liberal.—*Quebec; Rideau Club; The Garrison Club, Quebec.*

LAVERGNE, JOSEPH. (*Drummond and Arthabaska.*)

S. of the late David Lavergne, Esq., of St. Peter, Co. of Montmagny, whose ancestors came to Can. from Limoges, France, in 1650 and of Marie Genevieve Delagrave, whose ancestors came from Berri, France, about 1750. B. at St. Peter, Co. of Montmagny, 29 Oct., 1847. Ed. at St. Anne's Coll. M., Nov., 1876, Emily, dau. of J. E. Barthe, Esq., ex-M.P.P. for Yamaska. Called to the Bar of Prov. of Quebec, 1869. Is partner of Hon. Wilfred Laurier, M.P. Was Mayor of Arthabaskaville and Warden of the Co. of Arthabaska for several years. First returned to Parlt. at g.e. 1887 and re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal and a Prohibitionist.—*Arthabaskaville, P.Q.*

LEDUC, JOSEPH HECTOR, J.P. (*Nicolet.*)

S. of the late Hubert Leduc, farmer, St. Léonard. B. 1865 and ed. at the Coll. of Nicolet. Unmarried. Is a general merchant. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal.—*St. Léonard, P.Q.*

LEGER, EDWARD H. M.D. (*Kent, N.B.*)

Ancestors came from [Brittany and settled in old Acadia in the seventeenth century. S. of Hypolite Leger, Esq., farmer and merchant in Memramcook, N. B. B. in Grandigne, Kent Co. 23 April, 1866. Was a teacher of Common Schools for one term at the age of 15 years and then entered St. Joseph's Coll. N.B. and took a classical course. Graduated M.D. at the Detroit (Michigan) Medical Coll., 20 March, 1888. M. 21 Aug. 1888, Elise Michaud, niece of Rev. F. Michaud, P. P., Buctouche. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at
