RYERSON, JOHN K., J.P. [*Yarmouth.*]

S. of Stephen D. Ryerson, Esq; and grands. of Francis Ryerson, a U.E. loyalist, who came to N.S. from Brooklyn, N.Y., at the close of the Am. revolutionary war. B. at Annapolis, N.S., July, 1820. Ed. there and at Yarmouth. M., March, 1843, Abby, dau. of Joseph Shaw, Esq., Yarmouth. A mem. of the firm of Ryerson, & Co., West India merchants. Is a governor of Yarmouth Seminary, a dir. of the Atlantic Marine Insurance Co., and a Capt. in the Yarmouth Naval Brigade. Sat for present seat until April, 1867 until last g.e., when defeated; again returned, Oct., 1872, on resignation of sitting member. A Liberal.—*Yarmouth.*
