or Person having or taking the Charge or Command of fuch Ship og Clessel, together with One og moze suffi= cient Sureties restoing within the said Province, Hall, befoze such Rum oz other Spirits thall be so admitted to an Entry without Payment of the faid Duty, give Bond to his Wajesty, his heirs and Successozs, to be taken by the Two Principal Officers of the Customs there, in the penal Sum of Kive hundled Pounds, with Condition that the said Ship of Aestel Hall, in her nert clearing out from the faid Province after fuch Importation, be laden with a Cargo of Lumber of Provisions, Horses or Weat Cattle, equal in Calue to the Rum or Spirits fo admitted to an Entry, without Payment of the said Duty as afozefaid; and that the faid Lumber of Provitions, Posses or Weat Cattle, Hall be carried to and landed in some of the said Colonies in the West Indies.

III. And he it further enacted by the Authority afore: Rum and said, That the Calue of the Rum of other Spirits so valued agreeadmitted to an Entry as afozefaid, and the Claime of the annexed Sche-Cargo of Lumber oz Provisions, Horfes or Weat Cattle, to loaded as afozelaid in the laid Province, thall respectively be estimated and computed according to the Caluations contained in the Schedule annexed to this Act.

IV. Provided always, and be it further enacted by the Valuations in the Schedule Authority asozesaid, That it shall and may be lawful for may be altered by His his Majesty, with the Advice of his Pring Council, by Majesty in Dider of Diders to be issued and published from Time to Eime, to alter the Caluations contained in the taid Schedule whenever it thall appear necessary of proper, upon any Beprefentation of Report made by the Governoz and Council of the faid Province.
