CAP. XCVII.

An Act to continue feveral Laws relating to encouraging the Fisheries carried on at Newfoundland and Parts adjacent, from Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe, until the First Day of January One thousand eight hundred and three; to the further Support and En-, couragement of the Fisheries carried on in the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights, until the Twenty-fifth Day of December One thousand eight hundred and two; to the making the Port of Saint John's, in the Island of Antigua, a free Port, until the Tenth Day of July One thousand eight hundred and five; and to the permitting the Importation of Goods and Commodities from Countries in America, belonging to any Foreign European Sovereign or State, in Neutral Ships, until the End of the War, and Six Months after the figning the Definitive Treaty of Peace; for reviving and further continuing, until the Twentyfourth
