

# Theatre UNB back with two new plays

If you're looking for something to do next week, why not take in a performance at Memorial Hall, as Theatre UNB begins the 1996 year with Neil Simon's *The Odd Couple (Female Version)* and Peter Shaffer's *The Private Ear/ The Public Eye*. These plays are the result of the Fine Arts Performances by UNB students Jennifer Brewer and Derek Winchester. The three plays are complex pieces requiring much interaction among the performers and provide an amusing, yet thoughtful look at relationships.

Ms. Brewer's directorship of *The Odd Couple (Female Version)*, is an energetic romp through the lives of six friends. This is the same play that became a classic movie hit with Tony Randall and Jack Lemon. The twist here, is the decidedly feminine

touch to the traditional "male-bonding" scenario in the original play. The cast have a wonderful synchrony among them; the rapport between these women is seamless. The notable "love-hate" relationship between Olive (Hilary Stephenson) and Florence (Tanya Atkinson) is well portrayed through the actions and dialogue of these two actresses. The remaining performers (Katherine Atkinson, Janet Galway, Jennifer Coates, Jil Beardmore, Jamie Brewer and Kenny Fitzpatrick) provide the perfect foils for the "odd couple".

In contrast, Mr. Winchester's direction of *The Private Ear/ The Public Eye* is a closer examination of the intimate relationships between couples. *The Private Ear* deals with the issues of obsessive attraction, sympathy and rape, as it follows the attraction that an introverted music

lover has for a beautiful woman. The tension between Doreen (Tracy Carr) and Bob (Kumar Sivasabramanian) mediated by their friend Ted (Paul MacDonald) is both gripping and empathic. In *The Public Eye*, the focus is on the levels of trust and intimacy in marriage, and what couples need to do to make a relationship work. It is hilarious to observe the interplay between Julian (Cory Scott) and Charles (Jamie McDonald) as they speak of Belinda (Erin Fellows).

The performances follow a repertoire style of theatre at Memorial Hall. *The Odd Couple* will perform at 8:00 p.m. on January 23, 25 and 27, 1996. *The Private Ear/ The Public Eye* will perform at 8:00 p.m. on January 24 and 26, and 2:00 p.m. on January 27, 1996. Tickets can be purchased at the door and are \$4.00 for Students/ Seniors and \$5.00 for General Audience.

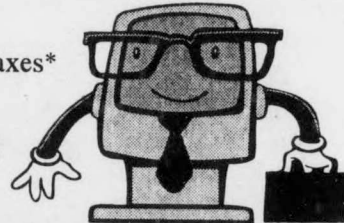
