

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the lands described as follows:

(b) the inquiry officer. (i) shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or

(ii) may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith. "owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the Act as follows:

includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian, executor, administrator of trustee in whom land is vested: 'registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and

whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper Land Registry or Sheriff's office and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll; The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he

desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.
