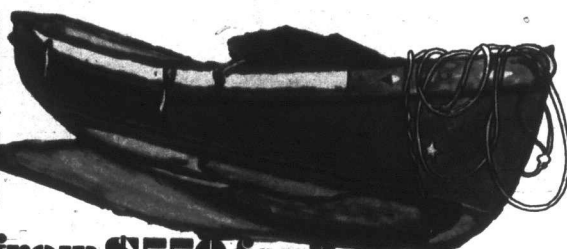


# BEACHBREEZE

### London

The Hawaii is a modern hotel with a wide range of facilities for which there are no extra charges. Dancing nightly, tennis, mini-golf and swimming pool.

#### OTHER MAJORCA HOTELS

**THE DE MAR HOTEL**, Illetes just 3 miles from Palma. A deluxe resort hotel.

Cost: From \$686 (low season) to \$820

**THE NIXE PALACE HOTEL**, Calamajor. A sandy beach, fine water sport facilities, private pool, nightclub, and a luxury hotel — The Nixe Palace — just 3 miles from Palma.

Cost: From \$698 (low season) to \$775

**THE BELLVER HOTEL**, Palma. A hotel that will appeal to those who want a hotel with all the amenities of a seaside resort and yet still be situated within walking distance of the city's attractions. The hotel is not on the beach.

Cost: From \$596 (low season) to \$695

### Tenerife

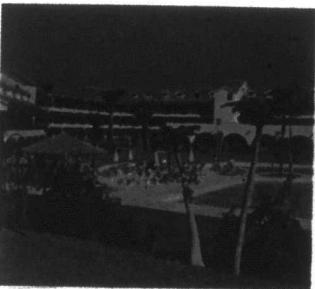
#### CANARY ISLANDS,

The scenery on the Isle of Tenerife is breathtaking. Flowers, exotic and highly colourful, bloom all over the island throughout the year. The main resort is Puerto de la Cruz on the North side of Tenerife. Originally a quiet village, whose picturesque balconied houses and gardens are still there, now a modern, smart resort, with many hotels, villas and a shopping centre in contemporary styles. The beach of black volcanic sand is small, but there is a magnificent lido right by the sea. By night it is a swinging place with many attractions, including a variety of night clubs, cafes, bars and cinemas.

#### PARQUE SAN ANTONIO

One of Puerto's finest hotels, the Parque San Antonio is built on an elevation and is situated one mile from the centre of the town. The dining-room, bedrooms, reception, lounge and bars are all built as separate units amongst beautiful tropical gardens with a large freshwater swimming pool.

Cost: From \$615 (low season) to \$708

#### LA PAZ

A superb four-star hotel overlooking the resort. Air-conditioned throughout, its amenities include two bars, a fine restaurant, two delightful lounges, hair-dressing salon, heated swimming pool and sun terraces.

Cost: From \$608 (low season) to \$693

### SAN FELIPE

Facing the sea and backed by a range of green mountains, the five-star luxury San Felipe is the premier hotel of Puerto de la Cruz. Standing sixteen storeys high and adjacent to the beach, the hotel is well-known for comfort and the excellent service it offers its guests. Tennis enthusiasts may unwind on the hotel's two courts. A resident band plays for dancing in the evenings.

Cost: From \$689 (low season) to \$758

### Greece

Fertile and colourful, Rhodes is our BeachBreeze destination in Greece. Rolling green hills, acres of vineyards and beautiful ruins in striking settings. Whilst much of Rhodes is a memorial to the past, her natural "holidays" assets have not been overlooked.

An elegant first-class hotel situated across the best point of the beach at Rhodes and just a 2 minute walk from the town centre. A varied and excellent cuisine.

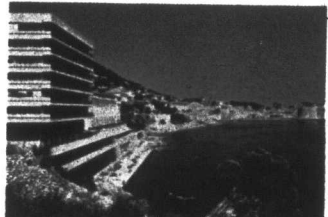
Cost: From \$683 (low season) to \$782

### Yugoslavia

One week in Korcula and one week in Dubrovnik.

Dubrovnik offers an extraordinary combination of history, beauty and every amenity for a sun and sea holiday. Founded 13 centuries ago the city has many fine old buildings, red-roofed houses and surrounded by massive ramparts.

Korcula is an island 42 miles off the coast of Yugoslavia. The old town is particularly charming, with ancient ramparts, towers and fine patrician houses.
