I am enclosing herewith a resolution duly signed by the Councillors of Pasqua Band requesting that a sum not exceeding \$1000.00 be spent on road work on their reserve.

They propose to build a road from the Agency down to the valley and if possible to gravel this road so as to enable the Doctor and Agent to have access to the valley in all weather conditions at present in wet weather it is almost impossible to give the Indians living down the valley any medical service, this road would cost approximately \$600.00, the balance of the money would all be spent on the main road running east and west through the reserve.

All labor would be Indian labor and as the roads on this reserve are in very poor shape I would recommend that their request be granted and the work completed this year. //
