Dear Sir:-

I forwarded monday through the office of Mr. C. Pant Schmidt, Inspector of Indian Agencies, Calgary, an account in connection with the above.

I trust my account will be acceptable at the figure of \$75 and disbursements. After a study of evidence had been made I discussed <sup>repeatedly</sup> case with the C.I.D. branch of the R.C.M.P. and the Attorney-General's department. This and their own investigations made them somewhat doubtful of ever obtaining a conviction. The charge was therefore withdrawn on monday and Lalonde must have gone back to Drifpile on the N.A.R. train that same evening.
