

any land on a Reserve belonging
to or occupied by such Band (inasmuch
it is not competent for the Super-
intendent General to confirm Mr
Fennick in his occupation of the
land.

In the 2nd paragraph of the letter
to you of the 12th instant, however,
you were given discretionary power
in cases where much loss or suffering
would follow a summary removal
to allow such time, not beyond next
autumn, to elapse before removing
the parties. If the circumstances in
the present case would appear to you
to justify it, you may extend such
indulgence to Mr Fennick.
