
Ottawa, February 8th, 1911.

Rev. Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo with reference to the payment of the second instalment of purchase money and interest on your land purchased from what was formerly known as the Crooked Lake Indian Reserve, and in reply have to advise that as the land was sold under special conditions as to payment of the instalments due, being for cash, or one-tenth cash and the balance in nine equal annual instalments with interest at 5%, it is expected that all purchasers will ^{meet} their obligation in this regard.

I am pleased to say that on the 15th June next there will be due \$197.20, being composed of \$136.00 Principal and \$61.20 Interest.
