
Ottawa, July 25, 1911.

Rev. Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant nominating Miss Sarah E. Whitehead as for the position of teacher of the Olo-oose school to succeed Mr. Gibson, who will take charge of the new school to be opened at Wyah.

In reply I beg to say that, while the Department would have preferred to obtain the services of a teacher with better qualifications than Miss Whitehead, she will be given a trial and will be paid at the rate of \$400.00 per annum, it to be understood that this engagement is only temporary and that Miss Whitehead's retention in the position will be dependent upon the results that she obtains.
