I have been asked to inform you of the following question and answer given in the House of Commons at Westminster on the 19th February.

Mr. Eden asked the Prime Minister "whether he has been in communication with the Prime Minister of Canada regarding the reported leakage of information of a secret character and whether he has any statement to make."

The Prime Minister replied:- "Yes, Sir. But as the matter is in the hands of the Canadian Government and it is sub judice, I do not think it proper to say anything more about it."
