P.M.'s Speech on Address

Recent Canadian naval successes against submarines.

I would just like to mention that within the past few months we have been able to announce the sinking by the corvette H.M.C.S. OAKVILLE of a German submarine in the Caribbean and the rescuing by H.M.C.S. MORDEN, also a corvette, of 194 men, women and children, who were passengers on a Canadian Merchantmen torpedoed in the Atlantic.

A Canadian Naval force of 5 warships co-operated with the U.S. forces in effecting a landing in the Aleutians while 17 of Canada's corvettes assisted in the landing of U.S. and British troops in North Africa.

Only a week ago, we were able to announce the sinking of a German submarine in the Mediterranean by a Canadian corvette, the H.M.C.S. VILLE DE QUEBEC, and today we were happy to announce a further sinking, also in the Mediterranean, of an Italian submarine by H.M.C.S. PORT ARTHUR.
