Dear Mr. Hopper:

Anent our conversation in the matter of the new Songhees Reserve, Cowichan Agency, I am informed that the title is in the office of the Hon. Attorney-General and is in the name of the Dominion as issued by the Province; also that the Registrar refused to register the title in right of the Dominion, owing to statutory obstruction since removed, therefore the registered title is still in right of the Province.

It is suggested that the reserve be included in the official Schedule of Reserves of Cowichan Agency and when the whole schedule is registered the title will be in the Dominion as in the case of other conveyed reserves.
