

The returns of survey are to consist of the following:

- (a) 1 set of field notes made up in ink.
- (b) 1 plan on tracing linen drawn on a scale of about 100 feet to the inch.
- (c) A separate description for each parcel of alienated land between the north boundary of Chekwelp I.R. No.26 and the intake at Seames Creek.
- (d) A description of the line where it lies in the right of way for roads.
