The Town parks shall adjoin and furround the area just mentioned, and shall be two hundred and eighty eight in number in every inland Township, and two hundred and eighteen in number in every Township situated upon a navigable river or water.

One Town-park shall be referred for a Minister, and one for a Schoolmaster, adjoining each other.

The remainder of the Township shall be laid out in Farm lots, the number of which in every inland Township, is to be two hundred and lifty two, and in every Township fituated on a navigable river or water, three hundred.

Two farm lots shall be referved for a Minister, and one for a Schoolmaster situated behind the Town-parks, to be referved for them respectively, and in that devision of Farm-loss which is nearest to the Town.

A Township, eight farm lots adjoining each other shall be referved in the hands of the Crown.

A ship, fituated upon a navigable river or water, ten farm lots, adjoining each other, shall be referved in the hands of the Crown.
