

DR. WADDINGTON'S CONGREGATIONAL HISTORY.

This Work has been compiled at a great expense of time and labour, on the part of the author, in collecting materials from Original Documents scattered widely in England, Holland and America, and nowhere to be found in a collective form, including the confidential communications of Kings, Statesmen, Prelates, Divines, Spies, Soldiers, and the letters of private Christians; many of which documents have never before been used since the day on which they were written; the very existence of many being unknown till brought to light after much fruitless search.

From materials thus laboriously collected and others more easily obtained, but equally reliable, Dr. Waddington has been enabled to produce a Complete History of the origin, life and working of Congregationalism both in England and America; showing how the first Congregational Churches were formed; the conflicts, persecutions, &c., endured by Congregationalists in the cause of Freedom, Purity and Independence, and, continuing the story up to the present time, with a full account of the origin and development of the many schemes for the promotion and growth of churches and the spread of the Gospel at home and abroad, which have occupied the attention of the Denomination during the last fifty years; including biographical notices of many venerated men who have recently passed away.

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
