## HOMESTEAD DUVIDA

attime who has been granted an entry for a homested is required a provisions of the Dominico Lands Act and the amendments in to perform the conditions connected therewith, under one of slowing plans;--

(1) ist least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land each year during the term of three years.

(B) If the father (or mottler, if the father is deceased) of the home-ender resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for be requirements as to residence may be entired by such person re-ding with the father or mother.

(3) If a sottler was entitled to and has obtained entry for a secon homescead, the requirements of this Act as to residence prior to obtain lar patent may be satisfied by residence upon the first homestead. the second homestead is in the vicinity of the first homestead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land. The term "vicinity" used above is meast to indicate the same town, township or an adjoining or cornering township. A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2), (3) or (4) must cultivate 80 acress of his homestead, or substitute 20 head of stock, with buildings for their accommodation, and have besides 80 acress substantially fenced.

The privilege of a second entry is restricted by law to those sottiers only who completed the dufts upon their first homesteads to entitle them to patent on or before the 2nd June, 1889. Every homesteader who fails to comply with the requirements of the homestead iaw is lable to ave his entry cancelled, and the land may be sgain threwn open for entry. APPLICATION FOR PATENT

should be made at the end of three years, before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent, or the Homestand Impector. Before making application for patent, the settler must give six months' notice in writing to the Com-missioner of Dominica Lands, at Ottawa, of his intention to do so.

INFORMATION, Newly arrived immigration Office in Winnipeg or at any Dominion Lands Office in Manikoba or the North-West Territories, information as to the lands that are open for entry, and from the officers in charge, free of expense, advice and assistance in securing land to yuit these Full information respecting the land, timber, coal and mineral laws, as well as respecting Dominion Lands in the Railway Beit in British Columbia, may be obtained upon applica-tion to the Secretary of the Department of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, Manikoha, or to any of the Dominion Land Agents in anitoba or the North-West Territories.
