HINTS TO HOUSEKEEPERS.

Peach Tapioca.—Soak a third of a cupful of tapioca over night in a cupful of water. In the morning drain it and cook it in a quart of water, until it is clear. Then take it from the fire and season it with lemon juice, sugar and salt to taste. Have ready nine or ten peaches that have been stewed until they are ten der. Place them in the bottom of a baking dish and mix the juice that comes from them with the tapioca, weakness and debility take their Turn the tapioca over the peaches; place. place in a moderate oven, and bake The most frequent, cause of dis-

in a jar. To one quart of vinegar allow three pounds of sugar, one ounce of cinnamon. Make a syrup poisoned and diseased. and pour boiling hot over the plums. There must be a sufficient quantity immediately.

For Canned Pears (unpeeled).— Wash large, firm pears in cold water, put into a kettle and cover with boiling water, and simmer until tender, but not until they begin to break or crumble. Remove from the fire and spread in pans to cool. Make a syrup of a pound of sugar to four pounds of the fruit and a quart of water and boil for five minutes, then add the juice of two lemons. Pack the pears carefully in jars, fill the jars to overflowing with the scalded liquid and seal.
