Petition read.

Major Murray, by leave, brought up a petition from the Reverend Doctor John Agnew and Captain Stair Agnew praying the House to establish and regulate a Public Ferry from their farms on the east-side of the river Saint John to Fredericton; and also across the mouth of the river Nashwaack.

Ordered, That, Major Murray have leave to bring in a bill for that purpose.

Report on the Miramichi road.

Captain Lyman reported the expenditure of the sum granted for opening a road from Fredericton to Miramichi, the state of the said road, and the sum requisite to complete the same.

Which was ordered to lie on the table.

Read the first time.

Bill read.

"A Bill in addition to an act entitled "An Act for regulating the Courts of Law established in the several Counties for the Trial of Causes to the value of Forty Shillings.

On motion made and seconded.

Refolve on the Nova-Scotia Laws. Refolved, That this House will take into consideration in committee of the whole House the acts and laws passed in the General Assembly of Nova-Scotia before the erection of the province of New-Brunswick and then in force, and to report their opinion of the necessity or expediency of confirming or repealing all or any part of such laws.

Major Coffin by leave brought in "A Bill for altering the "Times of holding the Court of General Sessions of the Peace and "Inferior Court of Common Pleas in King's County."
