July next, Tishigah and Aspy Bay, and the
same are hereby constituted and erected into
Out Ports of Entry; and it is further or-
dered, that Tishigah be placed under the
survey of the Port of Amherst, and Aspy
Bay under the survey of the Port of Bad-
deck.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the
31st year of Her Majesty's reign,
entitled, "An Act for the Union of Canada,"
Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, and
the Government thereof, and for purpo-
ses connected therewith, it is amongst
other things enacted, that a Bill reserved
for the consideration of the Governor
General shall not have any force
unless and until within one year from the
day on which it was presented to the Lieut-
enant Governor for the Governor General's
assent, the Lieutenant Governor signi-
fies by Speech or Message to each of the
House of the Legislature, or by Procla-
mation, that it has received the assent of
the Governor General in Council.
And whereas on the 15th day of May
ultimo, the Lieut. Governor of the Province
of New Brunswick reserved a certain Bill
passed by the Legislative Council and As-
sembly of the said Province, entitled: "A
Bill relating to the Synod of the Church of
England in the Diocese of Fredericton and
Province of New Brunswick," for the sig-
nification of the Governor General's plea-
sure thereon.
And whereas that said Bill so reserved
as aforesaid, has been laid before the Gov-
ernor General in Council, and it is expedi-
ent that the said Bill should be assented to
by the Governor General.
Now therefore, the Governor Gen-
eral, in pursuance of the said Act and in the
exercise of the powers thereby reserved to
the Governor General as aforesaid, doth
by this present Order, by and with the
advice of his Privy Council, declare His as-
sent to the said Bill.
And the Secretary of the Pro-
vince is to give the necessary directions
herein accordingly.

remove any vessel from one wharf to
another within the limits of the Harbor, or

Harbor to the foot of the current, or to
Longueuil, shall be entitled to demand and
receive for each such service the sum of
Five Dollars currency.

ON the recommendation of the Hon. the
Minister of Customs, and for the reasons
given in his report of said June inst.,
His Excellency has been pleased to order,
and it is hereby ordered, that the Red River,
in the Province of Manitoba, from the
point of its intersection with the Boundary
Line between the United States and the
said Province of Manitoba (Canada), to the
junction with Lake Winnipeg, shall be and
the same is hereby declared to be comprised
within the limits of the Port of Winnipeg
under the following conditions and
subject to such regulations, that it is to be
observed, that in no case shall any place
between that Port and the Port of Winnipeg,
they be permitted, on the warrant of the
Lieut. Collector, to land and discharge such
goods, or the luggage of such passengers as
may desire to disembark, before reaching
the said Port of Winnipeg.
That in like manner, after payment of
duties at the Port of Winnipeg, the same
privilege be granted them as at the same
Port—land and discharge goods and pas-
sengers, and the restrictions aforesaid at any place
on the Red River above or below Winnipeg,
and all steamers plying within the limits,
and observing the conditions aforesaid,
shall be considered and treated as trading
within the limits of the said Port of Win-
nipeg.
