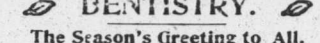

Before entering any child upon the Register of the Public School, or admitting such child to teach Public School, there shall be caused by such child, or by its parent, or guardian, or some person acting on behalf of such child, a certificate, to the effect that such child has been vaccinated; and if there are more teachers than one of any such school, to the satisfaction of the Principal thereof, that such child has been successfully vaccinated within three years from the date of such certificate, or registry of such child, and that such child has been vaccinated within the said period of three years and the vaccination has not been successful, there shall be produced to such teacher or Principal satisfactory evidence that such child has been vaccinated, or previously fully vaccinated, such certificate or registry cannot be successful, or that such child is immune.
