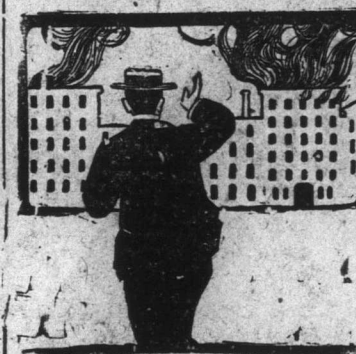

**Leave of Absence to Men
Class 1, Under Military
Service Act, 1918.**

On the recommendation of the Military Service Board and the Public Health Officer, leave of absence without pay until Sunday, 15th of December next, has been granted to all men in Class 1, who have been ordered by the Registrar under the Military Service Act, 1918, to report at the Armoury for duty on September 15th, and who were granted leave of absence on November 15th. This extension of leave is granted owing to prevalence of the epidemic Influenza.
