**PUBLIC NOTICE.**  
**SCARLET FEVER.**

The attention of the public is called  
to the following sections of the Rules  
and Regulations for the Prevention of  
Scarlet Fever and Diphtheria.  
1. In all cases of scarlet fever and  
diphtheria (including diphtheritic  
or membranous croup), every med-  
ical practitioner who shall attend  
on such case shall immediately or  
within twelve hours after he has  
ascertained the facts of such dis-  
ease, report the same in writing to  
the Public Health Officer, under a  
penalty for each offence of not less  
than ten nor more than fifty dollars.  
2. Every household, so soon as he  
shall become aware that any oc-  
cupant of his house is suffering  
from scarlet fever or diphtheria,  
shall give notice of such disease to  
the Public Health Officer, under a  
penalty for each offence not ex-  
ceeding fifty dollars.
