

London Must Win Protest and Twice Today To Stay In Running

WETZEL'S MEN FORCED TO DIVIDE WITH HAMS

Reis Loses Tough Duel To Hughes 2-1 In First—Hains Wins Second After Carmen and Weinicke Are Derricked.

THE Hams creamed final all over London's chances of grabbing the second half unless the Mint League directors decide in favor of London's protest of the use of two hurlers from the Syracuse International League Club, by forcing Wetzels' cohorts to divide yesterday's double-header. Four thousand fans, a good portion of them in cars which banked every open space in the park, saw the old men led by Calbert throw away their crutches and jump into the first affair, which they took by a score of 2-1. They lost the second in which both Carmen and Weinicke, southpaws, had been derrickd in the middle of the abbreviated pastime, by a score of 7-6.

Between games, City Clerk Baker, acting for Mayor Wilson and President T. J. Halligan of the Mint League, essayed the task of hoisting the two pennants, one of them the new one won in 1920 by the Tecs. Finally, with help from able seamen in the crowd's nest, the pennant finally flew to the breeze.

Decisions Not Hits. Decisions for which the umpires couldn't be blamed practically decided the duel between Reis and Hughes in the first game, and breaks, such as Rabbit Oakes getting a two-bagger and Carlin a single, were against the home team. London had started bidding for the game in the third frame, when with one going Carlin's bat threw, which drew Kuhn up into the air. Butler's sacrifice and Maimquet's walk put two on, and in the fourth inning, when Schaefer grounded out, though, and the jammed masses of fans let go a lot of accumulated steam, London was still in the lead. Power was on the wrong foot. There was a decided slump, and a rift in the harmonious haze, when Schaefer opened the fifth with a triple through a gap in the cars near home-run corner. Calbert became radiator any. Acting on a hit-and-run signal, Mackey, with the first ball pitched, started for the plate, but whether by accident or design, Hughes crossed the plate up badly by throwing his left arm, which went just over his head. Oakes, c.f., was hit, but Mackey had been trapped. Boyie singled, but was out.

Cogan had walked to start the fifth, and Stutz coming in with the rest of the infield for a bunt, looked sea-sick as he tried to put the brakes on and scramble back after Reis' little pop, which went just over his head. Mackey were safe. Simpson went banded down a grounder at Dolly Gray, and Simpson was also doubled at first. Fans back of center field said afterwards Gray failed to touch base, and his support took on a new supply of courage.

Back Boyie made a sensational leaping stab of Hunter's foot, which made the third out, and probably saved trouble, as Gray was on second, and Kuhn and Calbert coming up.

It just put it off an inning, though, as Kuhn opened the next frame with a triple into the left field corner, and a smash through the infield scored him with the first run.

In the eighth, though, five times, with three walks and two sacrifices, was heading off the London dugout, and Schaefer's perfect peg killed him off.

Two were gone in the eighth when Calbert doubled to right. He rounded the third and dashed for home on Carlin's long single to left, and was called out when he kicked the ball out of Mackey's hand. Griffin had to reverse his decision, and call him safe, with the winning run.

Schaefer's triple opened the curtain on the ninth, and Mackey's sacrifice fly to left scored him. Calbert's throw hitting near the London dugout, Gadsby, like a bull, hit the bases and a bullet-like smash, but he hung on, and threw him out.

Men, punch-hitting grounded out, and George Washington Stutz, and that was distinctly bad.

The Second Affray. Carmen and Gadsby pretty nearly threw the second affair away to the Hams, but it was pulled out, badly angled, in the fourth, when Weinicke got the sun in his eyes and Carlin, forcing in two runs with a second walk and a hit batsman before Miller relieved him. Miller continued the wildness of his predecessor, walking Butler, which forced in the third run, and a single to left, scoring two runs and tying up the score.

London had scored one run in the third inning, while the Hams in four frames had amassed half a dozen. The London run came cheaply, as Carmen, scoring after he had drawn a walk when Stutz threw into the dirt on Butler's grounder.

Gray's triple in the first was tallied by Stutz's single through third, making a fine stop of the smash. Oakes landed at home to start off the second frame, Gadsby threw away over the head, Carlin's triple scored it, but Carlin was nipped by Gadsby's throw to the plate on Weinicke's fielder's choice. Gadsby made another noble throw, but Carlin took Stutz's choice for an out at second.

Hunter opened with a single in the third, and Kuhn sacrificed. Calbert
