THE ARMY AT WORK.

LONDON, Aug. 9.-An official dispatch from Simla reports that the British force of cavalry and infantry and artillery which was sent from Peshawar yesterday to punish the rebels in the Mohammedan country, who under the Mullah attacked Fort Shabakdar, on Saturday, have overtaken them and defeated them after a hard fought engagement. The losses of the British were twelve killed and forty-eight wounded, the latter in-cluding three officers luding three officers. CATRO, Aug. 9.—The Anglo-Egyptian expedition up the Nile attacked Abu Hamid on July 29, and captured the place after severe fighting. Major Syd-ney and Lieut. Fitz Clarence were killed.
