CHICAGO WHEAT IS LOWER.

LARGE INCREASE IN STORE AND A FLOUT TO EUROPE. Further Engagements of Gold at New York—Canadian Securities Quiet, While New York Closed Strong—Decline in Sterling Exchange—Advance in Oil and Decline in Cotton.

Monday Evening, Dec. 17. The earnings of Canadian Pacific for the second week of December are \$300,000, an increase of \$100,000 as compared with the corresponding week of last year. Towards the close of the day sterling exchange rates were reduced 1/2c at New York. Canada firmer, closing at 103 5/16 for money and account.

Canadian Pacific ending closing in London today at 91 1/2. Paul October, 91 1/2. Erie at 10 1/8. Reading at 7 3/8 and N. Y. C. 101 1/2. As the result of the United States bond issue the gold in the Treasury was increased to \$110,000,000. The amount has now been reduced to \$87,000,000 three millions below legal requirements.

Corn on passage to Europe \$3.75, 200 bushels, an increase to \$3.00 bushels for the week. Considerable interest was manifest today among local dealers on the announcement that the visible supply of barley in Canada and the United States has decreased over a million bushels for the week.

English farmers' deliveries of wheat the past week were 60,540 quarters, average price 40s 10d, was 20s 7d. The English visible supply increased 115,000 bushels during the week. India shipments of wheat the past week were 280,000 bushels, as compared with 440,000 bushels the corresponding week of last year, and unchanged at 2,000,000 bushels.

Imports into the United Kingdom the past week: Wheat, 240,000 qrs.; maize, 120,000 qrs.; flour, 225,000 barrels. Money Markets. Money on call is steady at 4 to 4 1/2 per cent. At Montreal the rate is 4 to 4 1/2 per cent. The Bank of England discount rate unchanged at 3 per cent. and the open market rate 13 1/2 per cent.
