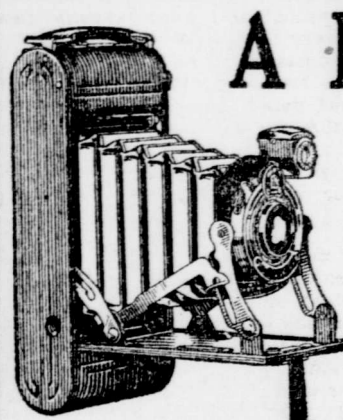

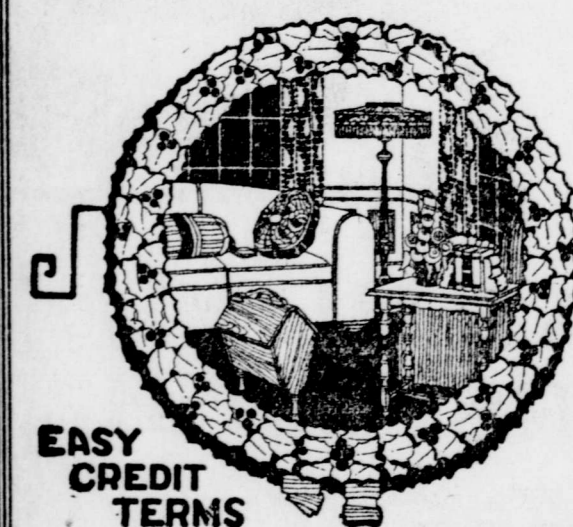

## ANCIENT CURIO EXHIBIT PROMISES INTEREST

Rev. G. K. Harris and Mrs. Harris, China, Arrange Fine Display

An exhibit of exceptional interest is to be opened at Talbot Street Baptist Church on Monday at 3 o'clock, under the auspices of the China Inland Mission. When there will be a display of models and curios characteristic of the Mohammedans, Tibetans, Chinese, Mongols and other aboriginal peoples of far-off Northwest China.

Some idea of the curios may be obtained when it is remembered that millions of these people live 40 days' journey from the terminus of the nearest railway. They have never seen a railway train or a street car; indeed not even a bicycle has penetrated into their country. They know nothing of radio, telephones or electricity in even its simplest forms would be miraculous to them. They have a civilization, however. They too, build houses, cook, farm and travel about their land and some of their implements and utensils are to be displayed in London.

The exhibit will be open in the afternoon from 3 to 5 o'clock and in the evenings from 7.30 to 9.30 o'clock on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Mr. and Mrs. George K. Harris, of Sining, Kansu, China, are to be in charge. The exhibit is free to the public and promises to be of rare educational as well as missionary value.

## WOULD ABOLISH WARD SYSTEM

Dr. H. L. Brittain Speaks To Women On Civic By-Laws

SCHOOLS AND TAXES

Head of Research Bureau Says White Collar Jobs Too Popular

The group of London women who heard Dr. H. L. Brittain, director of the citizens' research bureau, at Hyman Hall yesterday afternoon made up for limited numbers by a keen and intelligent interest in the matters under consideration and the ensuing discussion brought out some of the most important points of the question.

Dr. Brittain, who was introduced by Col. W. J. Brown, spoke on the by-laws which are to be voted on by the citizens of London on Monday, the reduction of the number of the City Council, the election of aldermen for a two-year term, the abolition of the ward system and the establishment of a Council manager system.

The speaker advised the city manager plan as a means of obtaining co-ordination between departments. "The heads of departments," he said, "must be specialists, not experts in getting elected, but experts in their jobs." "The ward system," Dr. Brittain declared, "is more firmly entrenched than

any other bad system in Canada. And it is the most expensive."

The speaker told of a device tried out successfully in other municipalities, where the candidates are nominated in wards or districts, but are elected by the city at large. "I believe in the complete abolition of the ward system, but where that does not seem to be feasible this is, I think, the next best scheme."

"Any public improvements," Dr. Brittain declared, "should be decided upon by the relative needs of the whole city, not entirely by the particular needs of one ward."

The decreased Council he thought advisable. Eight men are better than 12 because they are fewer," he commented, suggesting the election of four new aldermen every year in a Council of eight to insure continuity of policy.

## PAY FOR A GOOD MAN

Dr. Brittain does not believe in the small-salaried city manager. "You can get a good man if you pay for him," he said. "There are officials you can get for a thousand dollars, but you stand to lose that thousand and a good many more before you are through."

"Will there ever be a time when taxes can be entirely done away with?" Dr. Brittain was asked.

"I couldn't hold out any such promise," was the reply. "On the contrary, I think taxes will increase for the simple reason that municipalities are taking over and are required to take over more and more work on their shoulders. I believe that there could be a reduction of taxes for the present services received and I think it would be well in Canada to reduce our taxes as much as possible for the next 10 years until some of the national debt has been accumulated is cleared off. But I believe that taxes will ultimately increase as the services they cover increase."

The school question came up, though a little before it was time to decide what students shall go to high school was the query. "It is a grave responsibility, this saying that such and such a student should not go to high school," Dr. Brittain stated. "There was a time when free public school education was considered a great thing for any municipality to take on. Now we have free secondary education, but the taxpayer should not have to meet this, for either the rich man's child or the poor, unless that child profits by his opportunity."

"I'll tell you what is wrong," Dr. Brittain said. "There is a feeling on the part of many parents that their children should not work with their hands. The collar job is very popular in Canada just now. The dignity of labor should be instilled into our children at home and at school. Let us get away from the ideal that there is more dignity in clerical work than in production. There are a great many men preaching to-day, who, in my opinion, would make better blacksmiths. And I am sure there are blacksmiths that would do better in the pulpit."

The speaker commented with approval on the London scheme of pre-selection citizens' meetings in the city schools. "The time is coming when our schools will be used for 11 months and two weeks every year," he said.

Col. Brown spoke briefly on the West-End University by-law, which, he said, was really a plebiscite, a desire on the part of the Council to get the approval of the citizens for the annual \$55,000 grant to the university. "The Council has the authority to vote a grant up to \$75,000," he said, "but they are anxious to get the voice of the people."

"If the city discontinue the grant the city loses control of the university, which is the only municipally controlled university in Canada," Col. Brown said. He stressed the point that this is not a money by-law and that every person on the voters' list is entitled to vote on the university grant.

## PAYS FUNERAL FARES.

LINTHROP, England, Nov. 28.—Money to pay "the necessary travelling and hotel expenses of any of my relatives who may attend my funeral" was an unusual bequest in the will of George H. Blackburn, of this city. He also left funds to be used as "tips" for hotel employees and cab drivers.
