Boroglyceride with Gelatin	100 "
Sodium Tetraborate	5 "
Sodium Bicarbonate	5 "
Acetanilid	2 "
Zinc Borate	$\frac{1}{2}$ grain.
White Alkaloid Hydrastine, equivalent to Tincture Hydrastis	15 minims.
Concentrated Thymol Compound	10 grains.

The Concentrated Thymol Compound is composed of Benzo-Borate of Sodium with Thymol, Eucalyptol, Menthol and Oil of Gaultheria.

An alkaline antiseptic combination, designed to neutralize the acid secretions of the vagina, and to render them mildly alkaline, thereby destroying the activity of any foreign organism, bacteria, etc.
