

3. To encourage exchanges of books, publications, periodicals, and other available information in the fields of public health, medical care delivery systems and medical sciences between libraries and appropriate institutions on the basis of reciprocity.

III EXCHANGES IN THE SOCIAL SCIENCES AND HUMANITIES

Both sides agreed on the desirability of continuing contacts and exchanges between social scientists and scholars in the humanities and noted that the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada and the Academy of Sciences of the USSR would:

1. Exchange specialists to conduct research and to give lectures in agreed areas of study in the social sciences and the humanities; annually up to ten persons from each side for a total of up to 20 man-months a year.
2. Provide the conditions necessary for the fulfilment of agreed programmes including access to study and scientific materials as well as, when it is possible, to laboratories, archives and organizations which are not under the supervision of the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada and the Academy of Sciences of the USSR.
3. Encourage exchanges of scientific books, publications, periodicals and other documentary material in the Social Sciences and the Humanities on the basis of reciprocity.

The financial and administrative provisions governing these exchanges are given in Annex I attached.
