His Excellency Jules Mbah today presented his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Pleni-potentiary of Gabon to Canada.

The ceremony took place at Government House at 11.00 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General.

Mr. M.H. Wershof, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor-General, were in attendance on the Governor-General on this occasion.

The Ambassador was accompanied by Mr. G. Anchouey, Commercial Attaché.

In December 1961, Mr. Mbah was appointed Permanent Representative of Gabon to the United Nations and in January 1962, Ambassador to the United States where he will continue to reside.
