CAE ELECTRONICS AWARDED MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR FLIGHT SIMULATOR CONTRACT

Canada's CAE Electronics Ltd. has won a contract to supply a flight simulator for Lockheed's P-3C Orion Long Range Patrol aircraft to the Royal Netherlands Navy, Louis Desmarais, Member of Parliament for Dollard, announced today on behalf of Trade Minister Ed Lumley.

Contracted through Canadian Commercial Corporation (CCC), CAE will deliver the simulator late next year to train Dutch naval staff at the Valkenburg Air Base in all phases of P-3C flying operations. This equipment will be similar to that supplied by CAE for the Canadian Armed Forces Aurora.

A Division of CAE Industries Ltd. of Toronto, CAE Electronics is a leading world manufacturer of flight simulators for military and commercial aircraft, including KLM Royal Dutch Airlines' Boeing 747, DC-8, DC-9 and 10-30 passenger craft.
