A PROCLAMATION

KNOW YE, that WE being desirous and resolved, as soon as may be, to meet
Our People of Canada, and to have their advice in Parliament, do hereby,
by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, summon and call
together the House of Commons in and for Canada, to meet at Our CITY OF
OTTAWA, Canada, on Thursday the fifteenth day of October next, then and
there to have conference and treaty with the Great Men and Senate of Canada.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent,
and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our
Right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor, VINCENT MASSEY, Member
of Our Order of the Companions of Honour, Governor General and Com-
mander-in-Chief of Canada.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE, in Our City of Ottawa, Canada, this thirteenth
day of June in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
fifty-three and in the second year of Our Reign.
