Resolution,—To increase monthly allowance and to provide that changes in orphan's pension under the Pension Act may be paid to student after he has attained the age of twenty-one: House to consider in Committee of the Whole at next sitting, 281. Considered in Committee of the Whole, resolution adopted, 291. Bill C-125, Minister of Veterans Affairs, 1st R., 291. 2nd R after debate, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, 3rd R., 304. Passed by Senate, 326. R.A., 330. 14 Elizabeth II, Chapter 15, S.C. 1965.
