Hon. Barney Danson (Minister of State for Urban Affairs): I am informed by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation that Professor Robert Swartman has not submitted an application for research funds. The corporation is well aware of the importance of developing alternative sources of energy and thus would give high priority to the evaluation of applications for research funds in this important new field.
