Dear Sir Arthur,

A few years ago you made the suggestion that the heads of certain departments in the University, should be considered as having some jurisdiction over corresponding departments at Macdonald College. I opposed this suggestion at the time, but now wish to modify my former stand.

One of the great difficulties in the administration of the Graduate Faculty, is to keep or maintain a standard between various departments. But when there are two departments in the same subject, this difficulty would be lessened if there was a single head, & I am suggesting that in those subjects leading to advanced degrees, & for the purpose of having a single standard of efficiency, that
