

WITNESSES.—*Continued.*

A witness refusing to attend, or giving false evidence, may be reported to the House, who may censure him, or order his arrest, (not being a Legislative Councillor) for a limited time, section 92.

Upon any matter being required to be verified on oath to the House, it may be administered by the Clerk of the House. If required before the Committee, it may be administered by the Clerk of the House, Clerk of Committee, or a Justice of the Peace, section 93.

Commissioner may summon witnesses to attend before him, section 128.—They may be committed on failing to attend (exception), section 129.—As to summoning Members of either House of Parliament, section 130.
