An Act respecting the St. Mary River Bridge  
Company.

**W**HEREAS the St. Mary River Bridge Company has, by its  
petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set  
forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:  
Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of  
5 the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Preamble.

**1.** Section 13 of chapter 112 of the statutes of 1901, is hereby  
repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

1901, c. 112,  
s. 13.

10 “The works hereby authorized shall be commenced within  
two years after the Executive of the United States, or other  
competent authority, has consented to and approved such  
bridging, and shall be completed within five years thereafter,  
otherwise the powers granted by this Act shall cease and shall  
be null and void as respects so much of the undertaking as then  
remains uncompleted; provided, however, that if such consent  
15 is not obtained within five years from the twenty-third day of  
May, 1906, the powers granted for the construction of the said  
works shall cease and be null and void.”
