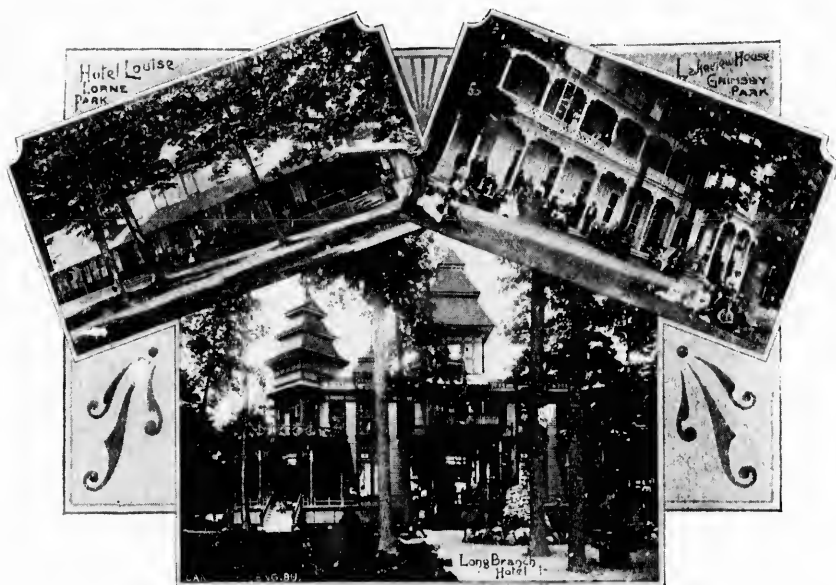


there is an excellent Sunday service throughout the city and to all outlying resorts.

TORONTO ISLAND.

The most popular resort of all, however, especially during the mild summer evenings, is 'The Island.' It is situated about 2 miles south of the city across the bay. The Toronto Ferry Co. furnish an excellent service to and fro up till 11 p.m., at 10 cents for the return trip. Island Park at the eastern end is favored by picnic parties, bathers, boating, and canoeing parties. Very popular with the tourists and Toronto families is the excellent private hotel presided over by proprietress, Mrs. Mead. Hanlan's Point on the west end is patronized by everybody; there is a fine hotel, refreshment and dancing pavilions, and entertainments, band concerts, ball games, bicycle and lacrosse events are held during the season.
