

TEN YEAR TERM FOR GENTILE CURED ONCE AND FOR ALL

Italian Counterfeiter Tried Summarily by Magistrate Denison in the Police Court.

THE PRISONER MAKES A STATEMENT

Anson Raymond and His Wife Committed for Trial for Conspiracy in Stuart Case.

Swift justice was meted out in the Police Court on Friday to Joseph Gentile, alias Salvatore, a Canadian counterfeiter, who was committed to the Kingston Penitentiary for ten years.

"I am ready to go on," said T. C. Robinson, K.C., when the case was called.

This was more than Crown Attorney Curry expected. "I don't think," he said, "that my learned friend is ready."

"Yes, I am," said Mr. Robinson. "I mean it."

Told of the Arrest. Detective William Davis of the plant, the United States detective office, was called next.

Flyn, who is qualified in the United States courts as a coinage expert, described Gentile's plant bit by bit. "The plant," he said, "was very similar to the one he had in New York."

No evidence was offered for the defense. Mr. Robinson wanted a remand, but this was promptly refused, as he had said he was ready to go on a statement from the dock.

Prisoner's Statement. Michael Basco, the Italian interpreter, went over to the dock and translated Gentile's statement as it was made.

The statement was this: "Last week some person came into my store and prayed me to let him stay a week. I granted it. The day after he came back with some things. He asked me to say nothing for a little while, and I'll let you know what I'm going to do."

On the same day he began to manufacture the things. I told him he would have to go somewhere else. On the same day the detectives came. I told him to go. This man went out the back door as the detectives came in the front. He was the man in the store. One revolver was mine—it was on a shelf. That is all I have to say."

A second charge. "There'll be a conviction," said His Worship. The Crown went on then with the charge of making Canadian money. The evidence in this case was the same as in the other.

"You found no moulds for Canadian coin," asked Mr. Robinson of Davis.

Mr. Robinson argued that there was no evidence that the Canadian coins were the work of Gentile. The magistrate held that there was evidence, and asked for record testimony. Gentile served eight years for counterfeiting in the United States.

Mr. Robinson again asked for a remand in order to call some Italian residents as character witnesses. Mr. Basco announced that Gentile professed to have a sweetheart to whom he was about to be married. He wanted her and her people called.

Ten Years at Kingston. On the lesser charge of making foreign coins, Gentile was given the limit of three years in the penitentiary. For making Canadian coins he was sent to ten years, the two years to run concurrently.

Detective Flynn was impressed with the quick way the case had been disposed of.

Inspector Stark asked him after sentence had been pronounced if he did not want to wire to his superior officers the result of the trial.

"No," said the officer, "not so soon, they would not believe it."

Raymonds Sent for Trial. Magistrate Denison committed Anson Raymond and his wife, Elvira, for trial on the charge of knowingly having William Stuart's counterfeiting plant in their possession. The case will be heard at the December Sessions.

The ball of Mrs. Raymond was renewed. T. C. Robinson, K.C., intends to make an application to Judge Morgan this afternoon for bail for Anson Raymond.

Detective James Forrest described to the magistrate what transpired at the Raymond house on the night of Stuart's arrest. The officers had been shown to a room, said by Raymond to have been that of Stuart. They found nothing that would make evidence against their prisoner, but later a remark made by Elvira Raymond led them to suppose that William was in Stuart's room at all. A search was instituted, which resulted in the finding of the plant. Corroborative evidence was offered by Detective Duncan and Policeman Gubrie.

George V. Sinclair, an expert engraver from New York, said the printing presses and plates could be used for nothing else than the making of counterfeit notes. The photographic plates, he said, were in the usual negatives, but were positives. The ordinary negatives would print a bill the wrong way about. George Kirkpatrick of the Assistant Receiver-General's office swore that the notes found were forgeries.

"Why was not Ethel Raymond's evidence put in?" was asked of Crown Attorney Curry.

"She has gone away. She is in Buffalo," said Mr. Robinson.

Mr. Robinson, counsel for the prisoners, last night positively denied that Ethel Raymond was out of the city. "She is at her father's hotel," declared the lawyer.
