

## PRICES HIGHER AT WALL STREET OPENING TODAY

Prospects of Larger Unfilled Tonnage Starts Steel Share Activity

MONTREAL QUIET BUT TONE STEADY

Dominion Glass, Brazilian and National Breweries Show Strength

Canadian Press. NEW YORK, Dec. 10.—Stock prices tended higher at the opening of trading today, although traces of irregularity were still in evidence.

Early buying orders appeared in substantial volume for Chrysler and Hudson motors, Baldwin and U. S. Rubber, which gained 1 to 2 points, but Schulte Stores was depressed a point. Demand for the steel shares increased on prospects of larger unfilled tonnage.

QUIET IN MONTREAL. MONTREAL, Dec. 10.—Trading was almost at a standstill at the opening of today's stock market, but the general tone was steady. Laurentide, the least inactive issue, sold up 1/4 to 87 1/2.

While B. C. Fish and Consolidated Smelters sold unchanged at 64 and 146 respectively, Canada Cement was the only weak spot, showing a decline of 1/4 at 103. The strong feature was Dominion Glass, up 1 to 91 1/2. Brazilian and National Breweries were also stronger, the former being up 1/4 to 78 1/2, and the latter 1/4 to 85 1/2. Steel of Canada and Dominion Cannery were unchanged in light trading at 97 and 14 1/2.

## Pool Room Case In Police Court

In the case of Leo Ruba, charged yesterday afternoon in the Police Court with assault on Wm. Truffen in Mar.
