Extension of timber license No.224

(Katit Reserve No.1- Pacific Mills Ltd.)

Timber license No.224 was granted to the Pacific Mills Ltd.in 1935 and the terms of sale stipulated that the timber must be cut and removed within a period of 5 years.

timber must be cut and removed within a period of 5 years.
The present license therefore is only renewable to
cover the season 1939-40, and would terminate on April 30th.

The licensee has represented that market conditions have preckuded operating and have asked an extension of three years from April 30th.1940 in which to complete the

undertaking.
As general lumbering conditions in British Columbia
have been adversely affected by the disturbed situation in
the Orient, I would recommend approval of the extension
requested.
