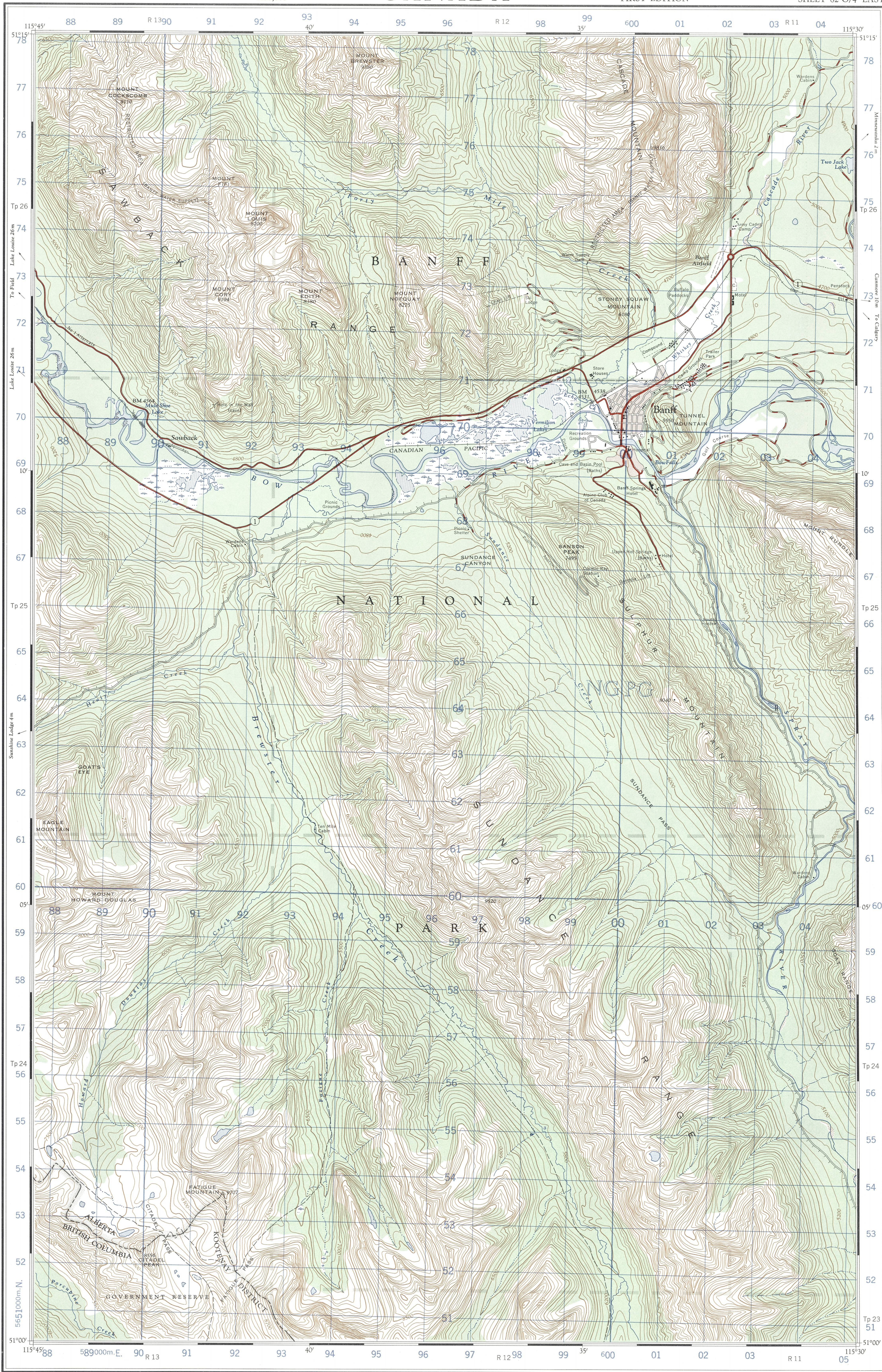


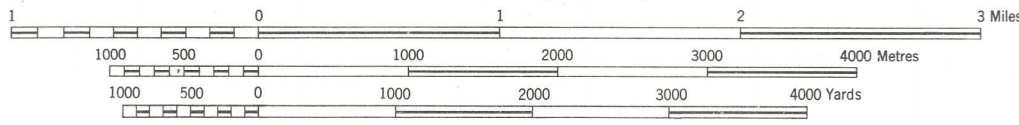


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BANFF ALBERTA - BRITISH COLUMBIA WEST OF FIFTH MERIDIAN

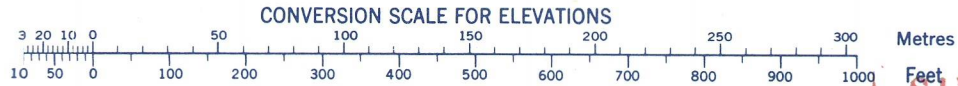

GRID ZONE IDENTIFICATION	
GRID ZONE DESIGNATION	11U
100,000 M. SQUARE IDENTIFICATION	NG PG
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES	
EXAMPLE: PICNIC SHELTER	
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	96
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.	7
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point	67
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.	8
MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	67678
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
