HISTORIC AND ROMANTIC SCENES.

The Loyalist Founders of St. John—Many Talents Among Them—Circumstances attended Arnold—Up to Fredericton—The Judiciary—Views of Quebec.

St. John is a Tory historic city. Go where you may you are constantly reminded that the place owes its greatness to those Americans who left the colonies in 1783. First is the public fountain in the park, which tells that "The Loyalists landed here on May 13, 1783. In another place one finds a memorial to the effect that Hon. Gabriel G. Ludlow, a great and distinguished commander-in-chief of this province, was a Loyalist from New York. Many old countrymen of the Loyalists, all the old records abound with references to them, all the local names of southern New Brunswick are redolent of their memory. In short, St. John and vicinity are careful to keep before the visitor's mind that that place was founded by those whom the Americans of 1783-1784 stigmatized as Tories.
