The Canadian authorities had talked the matter over and Canada was a result prepared to loan sufficient riftes to Britain this year so that by next year English soldiers would be so practiced in their use so as not to be taken at any disadvantage by the Canadian team with the same arm. However, if the war office wished to use this sight, they had every opportunity of obtaining it in England. It was quite evident that in stacting the new regulations, they had only one object, and that, to force the Canadian team to use the obsolete arm.
